


Most organizations offer in-person and remote onboarding



Percentage of organizations by onboarding timeline






Percentage of companies offering mentoring





Frequency of mentor meetings









Methodology





Data collection methods

In an effort to better understand the state of onboarding in a hybrid world as well as how and when organizations use employee onboarding gifts, 4imprint surveyed Wisconsin SHRM 2021 State Conference in October 2021 and through two online survey panels in November and December 2021.


A total of 445 respondents were surveyed. Unless otherwise stated, the data that appeared in this e-book is based on these responses.






